What we Community Health Workers do

As Community Health Workers, we empower our communities and link people to needed health care information and services where:

- There are limited resources
- There is lack of access to quality health care
- There is lack of means to pay for health care
- People do not speak fluent english
- People have cultural beliefs, values and behaviors that are different from those of a western health care system
